Thurs. 20th July 1962

In conjunction with the Cup quite a few trophies were competed for with the following results. 18 Hole Handicap, Barbara Sinclair took the honours with a nett 60 against a 61 by G Cartwright of Caragabal. The 18 Hole Stableford point competition, was won by M Hall of Caragabal with 37 points against Bess Kelly of Quandialla with 35. Regardless of the results, a very good day was enjoyed by all present.
